



Eni Motorrad Grand Prix

Back in action with the intermediate class at Eni Motorrad Grand Prix Deutschland of this weekend, ninth of the 17th events of the 2011 calendar

Leading the entire group the home rider Stefan Bradl of Viessman Kiefer Racing, currently leading the championship with a lead of 52 points on the rest of the class. Bradl has reinforced his position arriving on the second place at Mugello, ransomed from the slip on the gravel at Assen, after a great battle that saw Marc Marquez putting his hands on the third victory of the season.

Michele Pirro: "I have recovered almost completely the physical trauma caused by the fall of the Italian GP at Mugello and I will face the German GP in good conditions. The last time I raced at the Sachsenring was in 2006 and after 5 years it will be as the first time. It's a very driven and challenging circuit that leaves no breath and alternates slow passages with changes of direction with long curves of average distance, especially on the left side. It will be important to work in a key race to conserve the tires that will be solicited on the left side for over 50% of the lap time."
