

Blauer Helmets : Victory in Valencia with Michele Pirro



First place in the last race of the MotoGP 2011 Moto 2 at Valencia; Michele Pirro has decided to dedicate his victory to his team mate, Marco Simoncelli, who died recently.

It's the first victory this season for the young rider, riding for Gresini Racing Team wearing a helmet from Blauer Helmets printed with the number 58 of Sic.

To celebrate the entry of Pirro in the sporting group of the 'Fiamme Oro della Polizia di Stato', Blauer Helmets has created a Limited Edition helmet, inspired by the colors and unique graphics of the Italian Police.

Grey blue with white stripes, the helmet is made with a special reflective film also visible at night. The helmet has been constructed according to the criteria of technical practicality and high performance. The materials they used are water-resistant and breathable. The Blauer helmet was worn by Michele Pirro for the first time in the 2011 MotoGP race at Phillip Island.





Born in San Giovanni Rotondo in 1986, Michele Pirro made his debut as a wildcard in the 125 Class World Championship in 2003, running on an Aprilia. Hired by the team of 'Gresini Racing Moriwaki Moto2', the youngster becomes a Moto2 race pilot in 2011. Michele Pirro wins his first MotoGP at the Grand Prix of Valencia. He finished the 2011 season on the 9th place with 84 points.
