

World Moto2 Championship 2011

Next stop Jerez

After the first race in Qatar, raced at night under very special conditions, the second stop of the 2011 championship will be played in the "caliente" Spain, the Andalusian circuit of Jerez de la Frontera. So, return to the races live starting at 10.30 am for the 125, at 12 and 14 Moto2 MotoGP.

With Valentino Rossi still asking for two months more to return to be competitive, the hopes of the Italian Queen class riders remain in the hands of Honda riders - Dovizioso and Simoncelli, while the Italians of Moto2 class will have their work cut out to beat the "little" Bradl, who after winning in Qatar has already been shown to be competitive in the pre-season test in Jerez and to whom will join the hosts Marquez, Simon and the ex MotoGP rider - Espargarò.



Michele Pirro: "Riding during the day will be completely different and I think the values will mixed on the track again. As for our team, we are confident in hot climatic conditions similar to those that preceded the IRTA test, in which our Moriwaki has been very competitive. The shape of the circuit suits bikes, in fact Elias won the 2010 edition, but it will be important to find a setup that can save as much as possible the rear tire and to reach the last laps in a condition to push again."
